Guidance from Act on Process

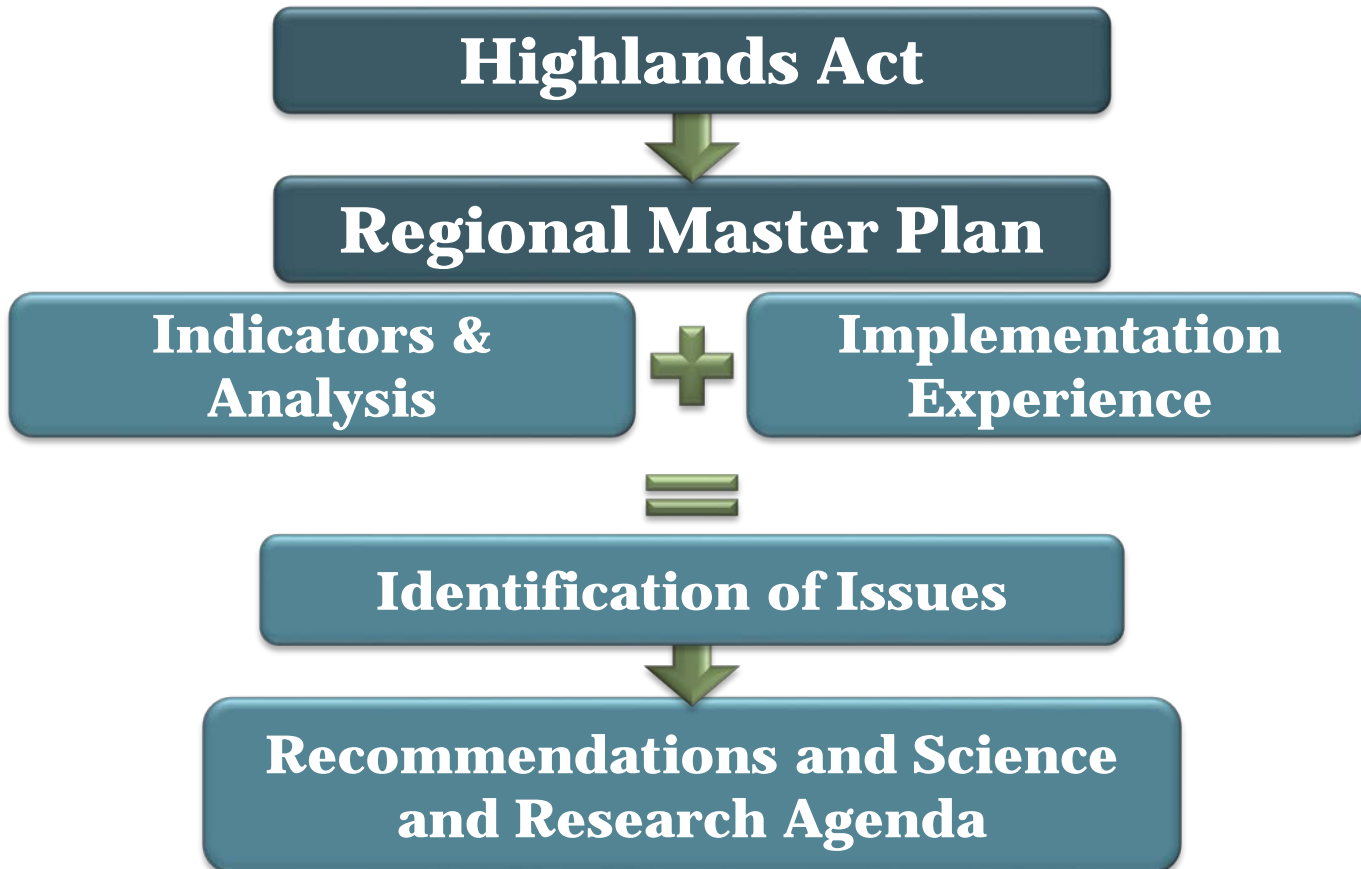
- Highlands Act requires RMP review “at least once every six years.” (Section 8.a.)

Guidance from RMP on Methodology

- RMP (Policy 10A5) prescribes “tracking and monitoring of regional indicators” through establishment of an RMP Monitoring Program
