### Updated Public Notice Highlands Applicability Determination Review Draft Consistency Determination January 5, 2009

Comments may also be provided by mail or hand delivery to the address above. Subsequent to the close of public comment, a revised draft Consistency Determination may be prepared. It is anticipated that the draft Consistency Determination for the above HAD application may be reviewed by the Highlands Council at its regularly scheduled meeting on **Thursday, February 26, 2009 at 4 p.m.** The Highlands Council may consider the draft Consistency Determination by way of a formal resolution in which case an opportunity for public comment will be provided. However, it should be noted that the opportunity for public comment at the Council meeting may be limited and that the Council may vote on the resolution the same day. Therefore, the applicant and the public are strongly encouraged to provide all comments and information during the initial comment period on the draft Consistency Determination.
