A	<p><b>PARC_STAT_MOD_1_EDIT</b> – Indicates the GDB PARC_STAT data field that requires an edit due to incorrect information that was previously submitted by the municipality or additional details that were not included in the previous municipal submittal. For example, in Module 1 a municipality would like to edit the data field [PARC_STAT_QFARM] from “no” to “yes”. The municipality would enter in this data field PARC_STAT_QFARM. <b>Please note that no other GDB PARC_STAT data fields may be edited at this point in time. All edits to GDB PARC_STAT data fields are made to this field only. This field may be used for multiple data fields that require edits, include all in this data field.</b></p>
B	<p><b>PARC_STAT_MOD_1_EDIT_DETAILS</b> – This field is required for all parcels that had the data field [PARC_STAT_MOD_1_EDIT] populated by the municipality. It must indicate the nature of the edit that is required and any additional comments. For example, the municipality would indicate in this data field that PARC_STAT_QFARM = yes. <b>This field may be used to indicate multiple data field details that require edits, include all in this data field.</b></p>
C	<p><b>PARC_STAT_MOD_1_EDIT_VERIFIER</b> – This field should indicate the full name of the approved municipal verifier for the edit.</p>
D	<p><b>WW_UTILITY_MOD_1_EDIT</b> – Indicates the WW_UTILITY data field that requires an edit due to incorrect information that was previously submitted by the municipality or additional details that were not included in the previous municipal submittal. For example, in Module 1 a municipality would like to edit the data field [WW_UTILITY_SERV_AREA_PERMIT] from “NULL” to “FACILITY XYZ _ NJPDES PERMIT ABC”. The municipality would enter in this data field WW_UTILITY_SERV_AREA_PERMIT. <b>Please note that no other GDB WW_UTILITY data fields may be edited at this point in time.
