Please accept this submission package with accompanying signed Resolution as a formal request by Roxbury Township seeking Plan Conformance from the Highlands Council for land in the **Preservation Area**.

Pursuant to Highlands requirements, Russell Stern, AICP, PP, Director of Planning, is designated the municipal point of contact.

We believe that "the municipality has addressed the requirements of Plan Conformance to the best of its ability," considering the limited time frame available to complete the Modules and the need for Highlands staff to process Modules 1 and 2.

Module 1 was submitted under a November 16, 2009 cover letter from Paul W. Ferriero. We look forward to meeting with Highland's staff to resolve errors, omissions and discrepancies in the Module 1 data and eagerly await the Highlands Module 2 Build-out Report.
